Our staff is prepared to supply breakfast and lunch meals, starting Thursday March 19th-April 3rd, for students who receive free and reduced meals regularly. We will prepare these meals daily and set up three pick up locations for parents. These sights will include Wendell, Levitt Lake and Shaffer Elementary. We will be sending out more details regarding exact locations and times tomorrow.
